### NOTES

**LAST TIME OUT:** The Binghamton Rumble Ponies dropped both games of Wednesday's doubleheader to the Hartford Yard Goats at Mirabito Stadium. It marked the first time the Rumble Ponies were swept in a doubleheader since September 14, 2022, also against Hartford.

**THE BIG DRIP:** Mets right-hander **Tylor Megill** is slated to make a rehab start with Binghamton tonight. Megill made a rehab start for High-A Brooklyn on Saturday and struck out all six batters over two perfect innings. The 28-year-old was drafted by the Mets in the eighth round of the 2018 MLB Draft out of Arizona and pitched for parts of 2019 and 2021 with Binghamton on his way to the major leagues.

**RUDY:** Mets outfield prospect **Matt Rudick** recorded a lead off single in each game of Wednesday's doubleheader. Rudick extended his hitting streak to six games and is hitting .458 (11-for-24) with seven runs batted in, six runs scored, and two homers in that span. At New Hampshire last week, the 25-year-old went 8-for-22 (.364) with seven runs batted in, six runs, two homers, and two doubles in five games.

**LET'S GET ROWDEY:** Mets infield/outfield prospect **Rowdey Jordan** stayed hot with a two-run single in the third inning of Game 1 of last night's doubleheader. Jordan hit .308 with two doubles, a HR, and 4 RBIs at NH last week.

**GUTS GLORY RAM:** Mets No. 16 prospect **Alex Ramirez** hit .333 (8-for-24) with five runs batted in, four doubles, five walks, and seven stolen bases over six games at New Hampshire last week. Ramirez currently leads the Eastern League with 12 stolen bases (12-for-15). He also ranks T-3rd in hits (25) and 7th in average (.309) in the Eastern League.

**RAMOS THE RELIEVER:** Right-handed reliever **Wilkin Ramos** tossed 1.2 scoreless frames in the first game of yesterday's doubleheader. Ramos has not allowed an earned run in any of his first seven appearances this season. He is tied for the most saves in the Eastern League with four.

**JUNIOR:** Right-handed reliever **Junior Santos** tossed two scoreless innings with a strikeout, while allowing one hit and one walk in the first game of last night's doubleheader against Hartford. Santos has thrown two scoreless frames in each of his last two appearances, and has combined to throw four scoreless frames with three strikeouts and just one hit and one walk allowed.

**ANDRE THE GIANT:** Right-handed reliever **Andre Scrubb** tossed three scoreless innings with three strikeouts, while allowing just one hit in the second game of Wednesday's doubleheader. Over his last two appearances, Scrubb has thrown 5.2 scoreless innings with three strikeouts, while issuing just two hits.

**LAST APPEARANCE:** Megill made a rehab start for High-A Brooklyn on Saturday at Maimonides Park and struck out six batters over two perfect innings, fanning every batter he faced on strikes.

**2024 SEASON:** Made first start of the season against Milwaukee on March 31 at Citi Field and allowed one earned run on four hits and three walks over four innings with four strikeouts...Placed on 15-day injured list on April 1...Made rehab start for High-A Brooklyn on Saturday, April 27 on Coney Island and struck out six over two perfect innings. He threw 31 pitches and 21 strikes.

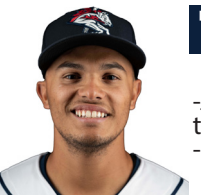
